2. A letter from their oncologist stating the diagnosis and year(s) treated.
3. A copy of **parents current 2007 1040 tax form.**

All of the above must be submitted no later than *April 15, 2008* to be considered for this award. **Incomplete information on application or the failure to include all of the above information will disqualify the applicant.** All finalist will be expected to meet with the Scholarship Committee before a final decision is made.
